Trunkline Gas Company, LLC (Trunkline) hereby electronically submits for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) the revised tariff records listed on the attached Appendix A to its FERC NGA Gas Tariff, Fourth Revised Volume No. 1 (Tariff), proposed to become effective March 14, 2019.

STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS AND BASIS

The purpose of this filing, made in accordance with the provisions of Section 154.204 of the Commission's Regulations, is to propose several housekeeping updates and clarifications in the Tariff. Trunkline proposes to change the word "intra-day" to "intraday" throughout the tariff in order to be consistent with NAESB language and other references to intraday in the Tariff. Trunkline also changes the word "nominated" to "scheduled" to clarify the basis for the daily scheduling variance in GT&C Section 3.2(B). Trunkline clarifies that public postings of OFO reports and right of first refusal notices/awards may be found on Trunkline's web site (GT&C Sections 6.6(A), 11.3(C) and 11.3(G)) and that the OBA form can be found on Trunkline's web site in the "Forms, General Forms" category under Informational Postings (GT&C Section 7.1). Trunkline is updating cross-references in Section 3.6(C) of Rate Schedules FT, EFT, QNT and LFT, Section 3.5(C) in Rate Schedules IT and QNIT as well as GTC Section 29.2. Names are updated for the URL of Trunkline's web site in GT&C Section 1, the referenced LNG company in GT&C Section 28.7 and the location of a published spot price in GT&C Section 5.2(F)(2). Last, Trunkline is revising the tariff record listing non-conforming service agreements to easily identify non-conforming service agreements with negotiated rates in GT&C Section 26. Trunkline is making a concurrent filing in its Original Volume No. 1-A to include this title in its Table of Contents.

IMPLEMENTATION

Pursuant to Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's regulations, Trunkline requests that the proposed tariff records submitted herewith be accepted effective March 14, 2019.
