STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS AND BASIS

In compliance with Section 154.112(b) of the Commission's Regulations, Trunkline submits herein an updated list of non-conforming agreements to reflect a new Rate Schedule FT service agreement with Rover Pipeline LLC that is proposed to be effective July 1, 2017, the anticipated effective date of the non-conforming agreement coincident with the in-service date of the Trunkline Backhaul Project and the Rover Pipeline Project.

Trunkline is making a concurrent filing to add this new non-conforming service agreement as a tariff record in its Original Volume No. 1-A.

IMPLEMENTATION
